Jubilee Year Ambassador Program

The Ambassador Program offers students a host of opportunities to grow in faith and gain important leadership, teamwork, public speaking, event management and mentoring skills. Student ambassadors will positively impact their school community. As the 'face' of the Jubilee Year, student ambassadors will also represent their school at a variety of events.

Jubilee Year student ambassadors benefit by:

- having a recognised student leadership role (badge)
- developing transferable skills through formation, workshops and hands-on application
- enjoying new experiences and making new friends
- gaining skills and experiences that improve their resume
- attending Jubilee Year events including the Australian Catholic Youth Festival (ACYF).

Mission statement

Jubilee Year student ambassadors strive to enrich their school community during 2025 by promoting Jubilee Year events and local school initiatives for faith, fellowship and belonging. They encourage the school community to get involved through positive engagement in student-led activities. Student ambassadors aim to be the 'face' of the Jubilee Year in their school and wider Catholic community, including at Catholic Education Week events, student encounter days and the 2025 ACYF.

Position description

The Ambassador Program is a voluntary, extracurricular program open to Year 6, 9, 10 and 11 students enrolled at MACS or participating schools. Applicants must be committed to the values of Catholic education and interested in student leadership, the opportunity to gain knowledge, experience and understanding as a leader, and sharing their faith in the school community. Up to six student ambassadors may be selected from each secondary school.

Duration

Ambassadors are appointed for the entire 2025 school year.

Responsibilities

Student ambassadors:

- contribute significantly to running student-led activities for faith, fellowship and belonging throughout the Jubilee Year 2025
- share their experiences with the school community at relevant events
- represent the school at Jubilee Year events, including the 2025 ACYF
- participate, make new friends and have fun.

Time commitments

Student ambassador commitments comprise student formation, and participation in school-based and MACS-sponsored events. The Jubilee Year will culminate in ACYF, to be held in Melbourne from **Sunday 30 November** to **Tuesday 2 December 2025**. Unreasonable expectations will not be placed on ambassadors in the lead-up to and during any assignment or exam periods.

Students demonstrate:

- interpersonal skills suitable for working with staff and students
- desire to be involved with and contribute to their school community
- ability to positively promote Jubilee Year initiatives and represent the school community
- engagement in the Catholic faith and an ability to express the faith more broadly.

Selection process timeline

- Friday 7 February 2025: applications open
- Friday 21 February 2025: applications close. Schools select applicants through internal processes
- Friday 7 March 2025: applicants are notified of the outcome.
